If any of these types of containers are discovered in bins by the College's Recycling Partner, the entire bin will not be collected.

PACKAGING

Polystyrene (Styrofoam)
Plastic or Styrofoam egg cartons
Meat, cheese, deli, or cookie trays
Berry cartons

Microwave trays or containers
Packing peanuts or blocks
Plastic bags, wrap, packaging, or film ("cling wrap")

HOUSEHOLD

Toys
Plastic coat hangers
Medical Supplies
Decorative light holders
Plastics from electronics or appliances
Pails, buckets, clothes hampers, or recycling bins
CDs, video tapes, cassettes, or cases

OTHER

Cups, Lids, Pumps
Jugs, Pails over 2 gallons in size
Small Pill Bottles
Bottles or containers that previously
Held toxic materials (i.e. Motor Oil,
Pesticides, Paints)

YARD AND GARDEN

Plastic swimming pools
Plastic Lawn Furniture
Flower or plant pots
Black plastic
