Emergency Response For Environmental Incidents: **PROTECTING STORM DRAINS** and **FLOOR DRAINS**

- Petroleum Products such as Oil, Gas, Diesel, etc.
 - Waste Cooking Oil/Grease from the Campus Center.
 - Degreasing and Parts Cleaning Solvents.
 - Battery Acid.

- If personal injury has occurred or if there is the potential for a fire consider the situation an emergency and contact College Public Safety as quickly as possible.

 - Cover or plug the drain if possible. Specialized Drain Protection Mats in long yellow carrying tubes are stored in the Transportation Shop of the CUB.

 - Inhibit movement of the spilled material toward the drain with long absorbent “socks”, absorbent pads, and/or granular absorbent from the Transportation Shop other appropriate absorbent.

 - If possible, collect the material as a liquid and place it in a container compatible with that liquid such as motor oil into the waste oil tank. If mixed with absorbent, place in a bucket with a cover.

 - Emergency or not, spills of over 10 (Ten) gallons must be reported. This is a federal and state law. Contact the Environmental & Safety Compliance Manager with this information as soon as possible.
