## Full-time Undergraduate Application

Western New England College has rolling admissions for all programs. We encourage you to apply electronically via our website, [www.wnec.edu](http://www.wnec.edu). This will provide you with personalized information and allow you to track the receipt of application materials. All freshmen are encouraged to complete their application before February 15; transfer students before July 1.

1. Complete this form and submit it with the \$50.00 application fee (\$40.00 application fee for those who apply electronically). This fee can be waived if your parent or grandparent is a Western New England College alumnus/a. Other alumni can waive the fee if they submit a brief statement in support of your candidacy. The letter must include their address, class year, and email address (if applicable) **under their name and signature**.

2. Have your official high school transcript(s) forwarded **as well as an official transcript of your first quarter/trimester senior grades**.

3. Submit your SAT or ACT scores. The CEEB number for the SAT is 3962; the College Code number for the ACT is 1930. The SAT scores should be sent directly from the College Board.

4. Submit one **academic** recommendation from a teacher or, preferably, your guidance counselor. Engineering applicants should submit a recommendation from a math or science teacher regarding your ability to pursue an engineering curriculum.

5. Transfer students should submit all of the above information along with official transcripts from all postsecondary institutions attended. (Test scores are not required if at least 24 credits have been earned.)

6. International students should review our website for additional information.

7. All students are encouraged to submit an optional essay of your choice or personal statement about qualifications.

If you want to apply for aid, you should submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with code #002226.

These programs are available to freshmen who typically have SAT critical reading and math scores totaling at least 1200 (ACT 27) and a high school GPA of at least 3.5 for college-prep courses. Transfer students cannot be admitted to the program at this time.
  - School of Business:** Five-year Bachelor/Master of Science in Accounting
  - School of Engineering:** Five-year Bachelor/Master of Science in Engineering Management
  - All Schools:** Five-year Bachelor/Master of Business Administration (not available to students in Criminal Justice, Education, Pre-pharmacy, or Social Work)
- In addition** to the Biomedical Engineering, I am interested in applying for the six-year bachelor/law program. This BME/Law Program is available to freshmen who have achieved at least a 650 on the critical reading and math components of the SAT test (total at least 1300) or have achieved at least a 29 for their English, math, and composite ACT scores. In addition, a high school GPA of at least 3.5 for college-prep courses is required. Transfer students cannot be admitted to the program at this time.
- In addition** to the above, I am interested in Pre-medicine.

\* Students selecting Education—Elementary **must** select a second major by checking a second box; it requires one of the following Arts and Sciences majors: English, History, Mathematics, Political Science, Psychology, or Sociology. (Due to credit requirements, Mathematics may take longer than eight semesters to complete.) Transfer students who have completed two semesters may need more than an additional six semesters to finish the requirements. Transfer students with more than one year of college credit must be approved by the department chairperson.

\*\* Students selecting Education—Secondary **must** select a second major which specifies the area of certification. Check a second box for Biology, Business, Chemistry, English, History, Mathematics, or Political Science.

\*\*\* Only recent high school graduates will be considered for Pre-pharmacy; transfer students will not be admitted.
